**Painting Materials:**

Oil Colors:

Titanium White	Cobalt Blue
Naples Yellow	Ultramarine Blue
Yellow Ochre	Raw Umber
Cadmium Orange	Black
Cadmium Red Light	
Terra Rosa	
Alizarin Crimson	

Palette (NOT WHITE): can be masonite or wood and treated with linseed oil OR glass with gray cardboard underneath

Palette Cups to hold Solvent and Medium

Medium: Liquin or Maroger/"Flemish"

Solvent: Gamsol (least toxic)

Brushes:

Filbert Bristles (two #2, two #4, Two #6, two #8): more of #2 and #4 if possible  
Round Sables (two#4)

Palette Knife

**Painting Surfaces:**

Stretched Canvases: 12"x16" to 18"x24" to be prepared with acrylic gesso, several coats, lightly sanded between coats OR rabbitskin glue with an oil primer. When surface is dry, very think wash of Terra Rosa to be used as an underpainting.
