

## **Supplies list for Art of the Beeswax Collage With Phoenix Forrester**

**Dear students, I am looking forward to having a magnificent time together!**

- 1. 3-5 Surfaces to collage on. Wood, old cigar boxes, canvas, masonite, almost anything. If you wish to gesso or paint the surface, please do so before class so it will be dry to begin when class starts. Otherwise do nothing to your surface!!!! And loose the glue!!! We don't use any!!! That's why this is so cool!!!!!!**
- 2. A small quilting iron (It is a little triangle shaped iron on a wand with NO holes on the bottom). They are available at Jo-Ann's fabrics and if you sign up for the 40% discount coupons, you can get it for about \$14.00. If you do not wish to buy one, you may use mine; there may be a little wait if others are using it too.**
- 3. Hot-air or Embossing gun, available at Michael's or Hobby Lobby. They are approx. \$20.00 If you do not wish to buy one, there will be at least one at class to use.**
- 4. A box of crayons, Crayola or other brand, any condition, they make cool dots on the wax!**
- 5. Old photos, words, postcards, journal entries, old stamps, whatever you like to collage with!!!! Even some small 3-D items are good, trinkets! Please bring more for trading!!! I will bring lots to share!!! This is the fun part!!!**
- 6. Scissors**

**I will bring the crock pots, brushes and beeswax. (\$5.00 due to Phoenix at the beginning of class for the wax)**
