

Mosaic with Vintage China and Found Objects

Supply List

Taught by Phoenix Forrester

1st Class bring:

Vintage china (approx. 10 pieces, i.e. plates, cups saucers, nothing needs to match!) You may break them up at home before class into small pieces, or wait until class. Also little figurines are fun to add to your piece.

One sturdy wood surface, like plywood or an old wooden drawer approx. 12" by 12", or a little table, to mosaic on.

A hammer

Acrylpro or other tile adhesive (small size is ok, approx. 32 oz or large size-one gallon if 4-6 people want to share.) Sold at Home Depot or Lowe's in the tile section.

Latex gloves to protect hands while gluing.

Heavy duty paper towels and old clean cloths that can be thrown away.

Mosaic is time consuming and the class will be mainly to glue the design on to be ready to grout the following class. You can always finish at home if necessary.

2nd Class bring:

Sanded or unsanded grout, the color of your choosing, get at Home Depot in the tile section (small size pre-mixed, **sanded** is fine, approx. 32oz. Or one large bag of dry that we mix with water. 2 small plastic containers to hold water and to mix grout in, (if you bring the dry grout that comes in a bag).
