

**Materials List for “Make Your Own Vintage Typewriter Key Bracelet”  
With Phoenix Forrester**

**Bring one bracelet to adhere the typewriter keys to. This needs to be something called a ring and connector chain. This type chain is the only one that will hold the weight of the keys and lay nicely on your wrist! Trust me!!! (They sell them in sterling silver at Rio Grande Jewelry). If you prefer a less costly bracelet, that is fine, they do have them at Rio Grande Jewelry in steel). The typical ladies wrist size is 7” and that will hold 10 keys. If you have a larger wrist, get a size bracelet to fit you. (Rio Grande does sell the ring and connector chain by the foot, as well).**

**Also bring, one tube of E-6000 glue, available at WalMart or Indian Jewelry Supply on San Mateo near I-40**
